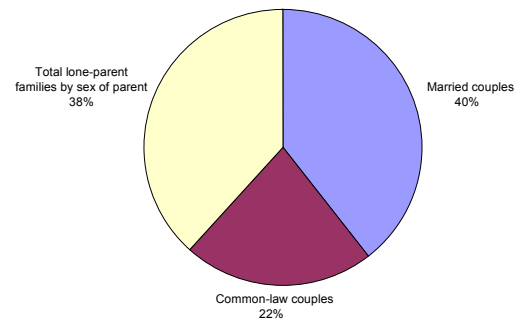

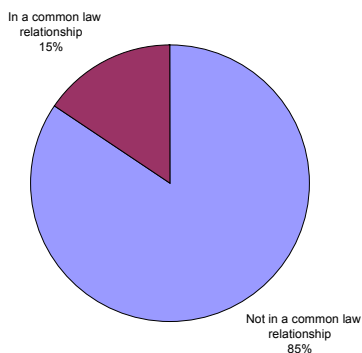

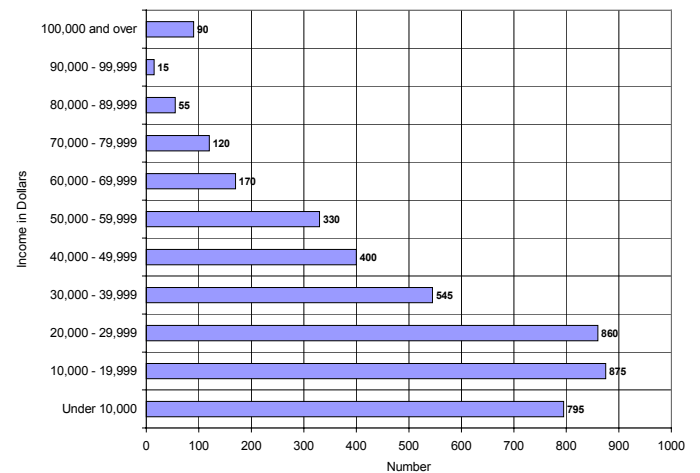
Aboriginal Population

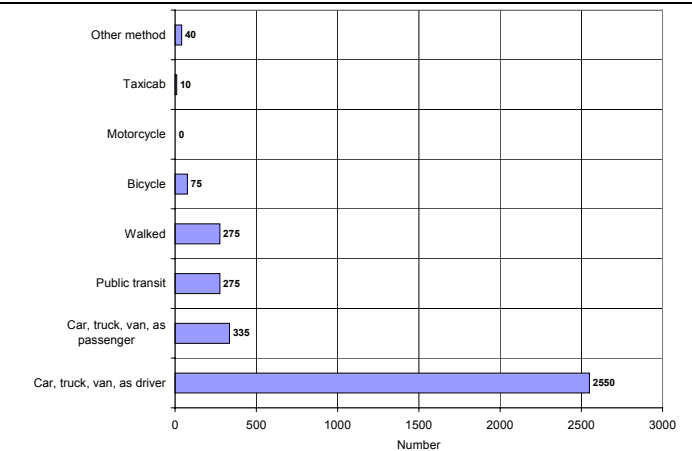

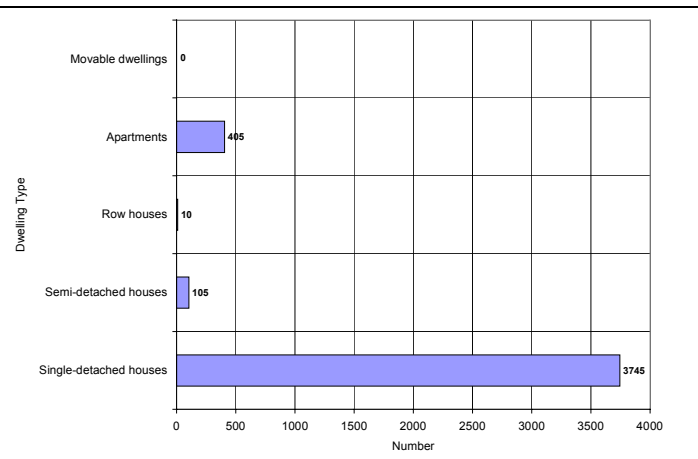

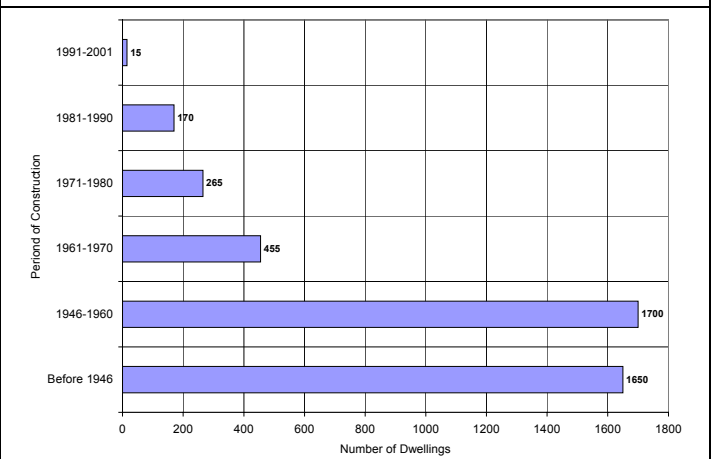
Mode of Transportation (employed labour force)



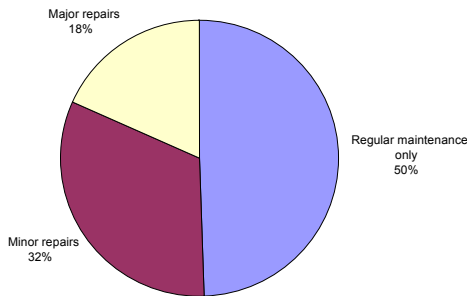
Type of Housing Stock



Age of Housing Stock

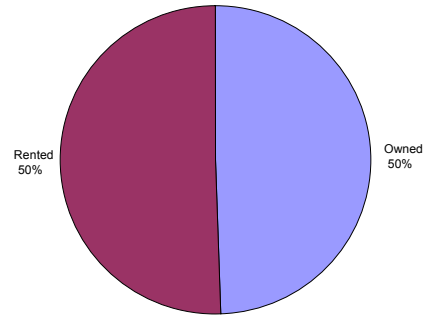
