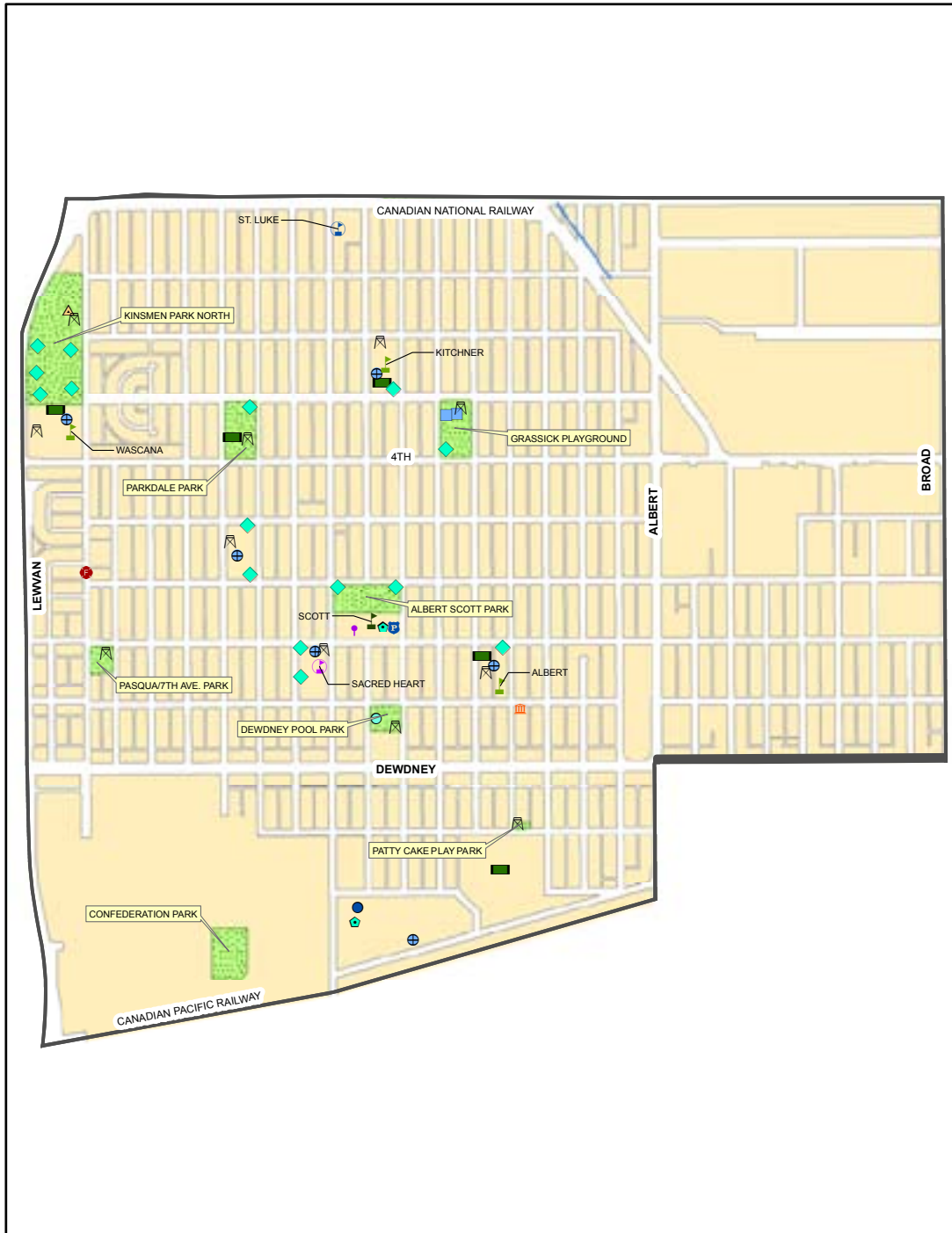
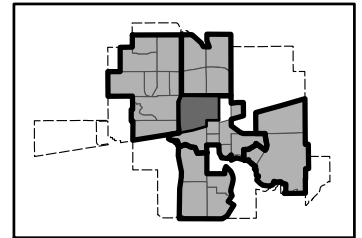

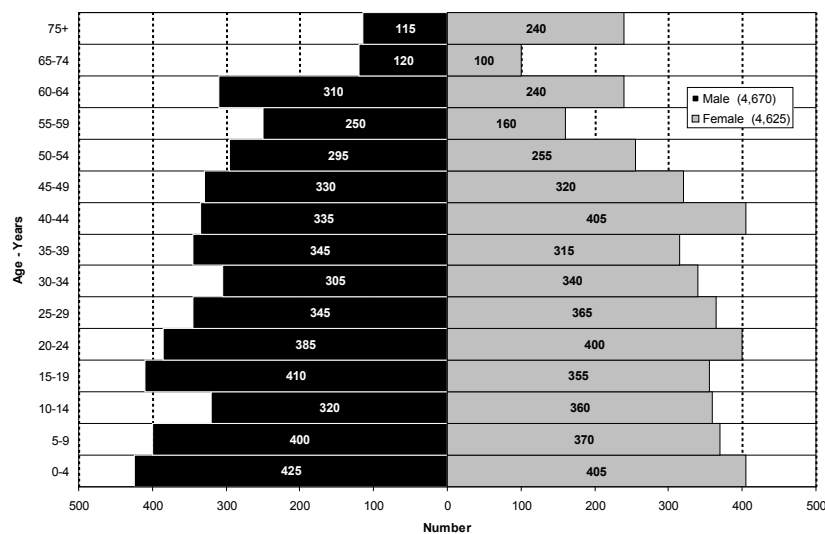
North Central Neighbourhood

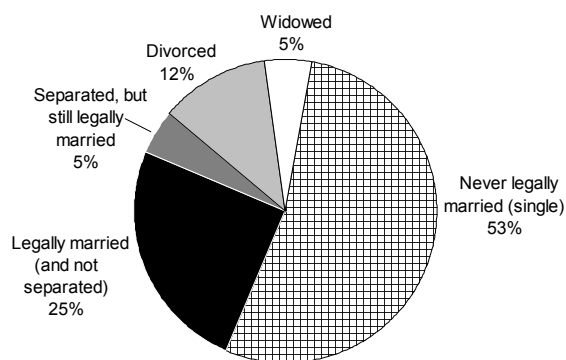
North Central - Known for its active community association

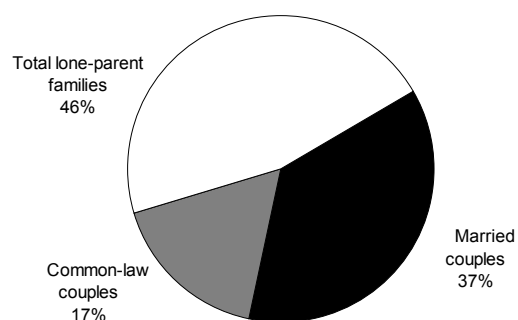

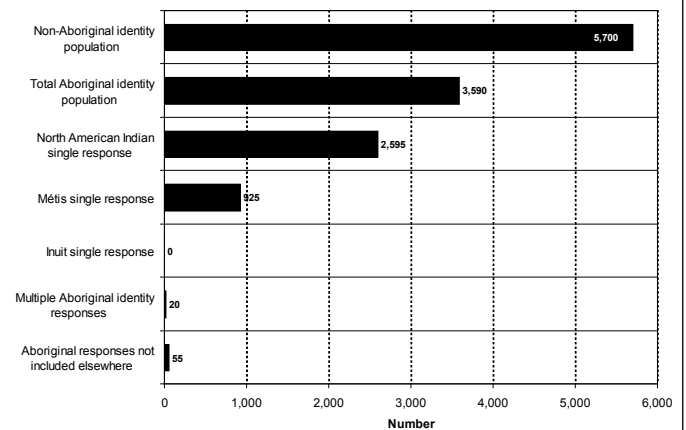

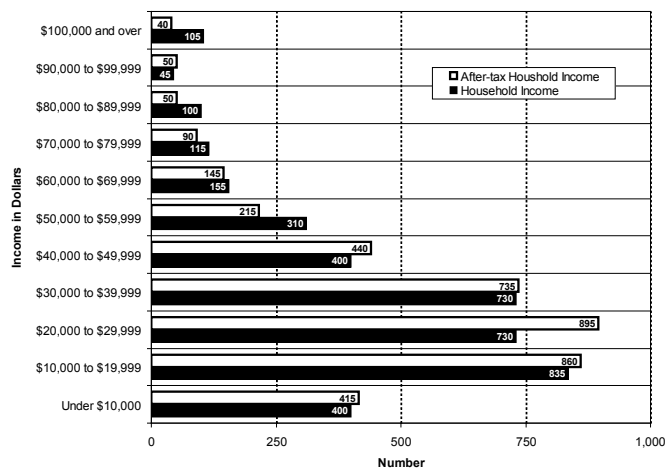

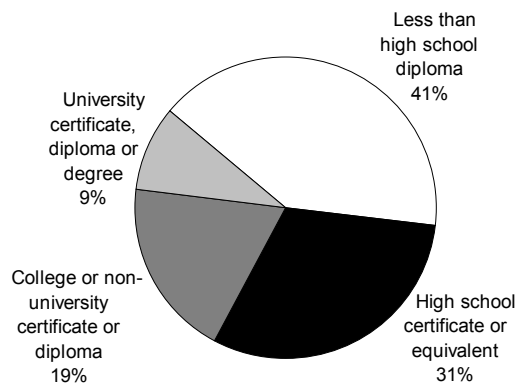

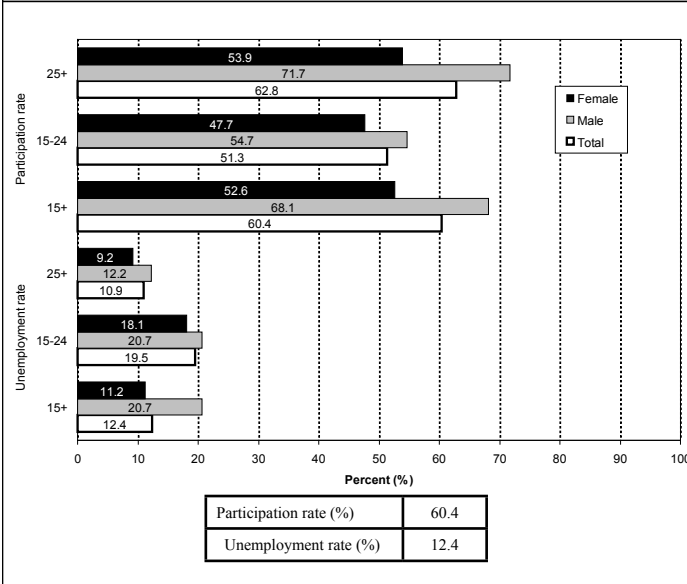

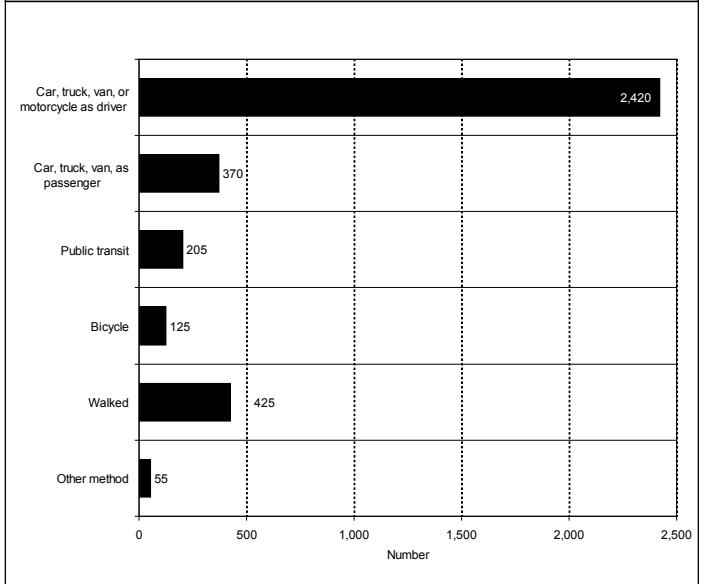

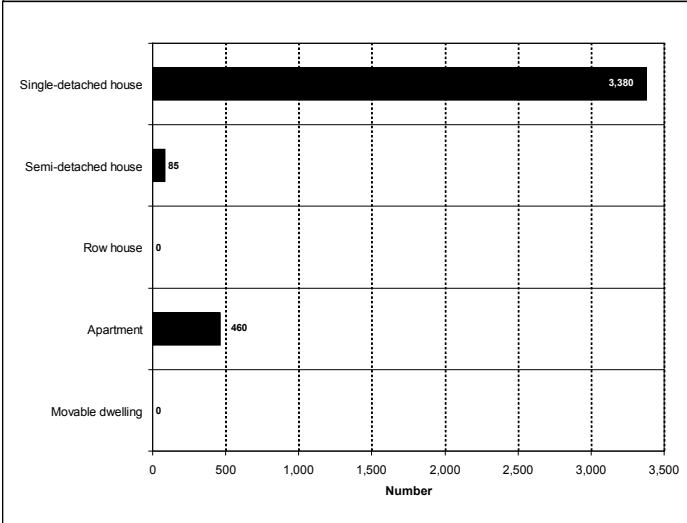
Labour Force Activity (15 years and over)



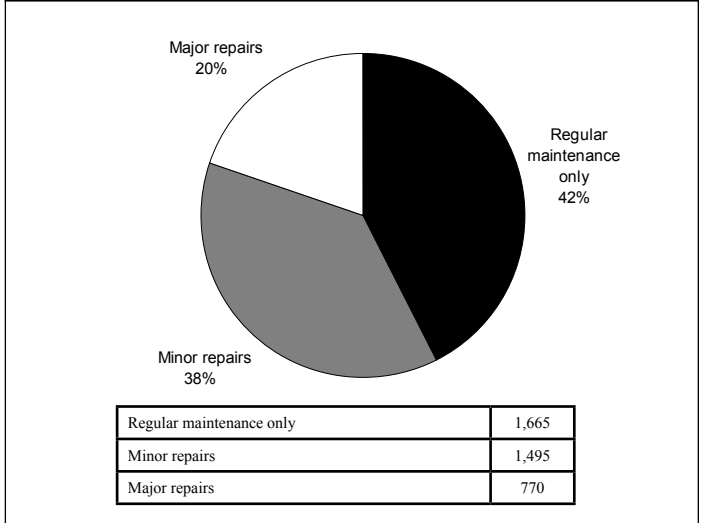
Mode of Transportation (employed labour force)



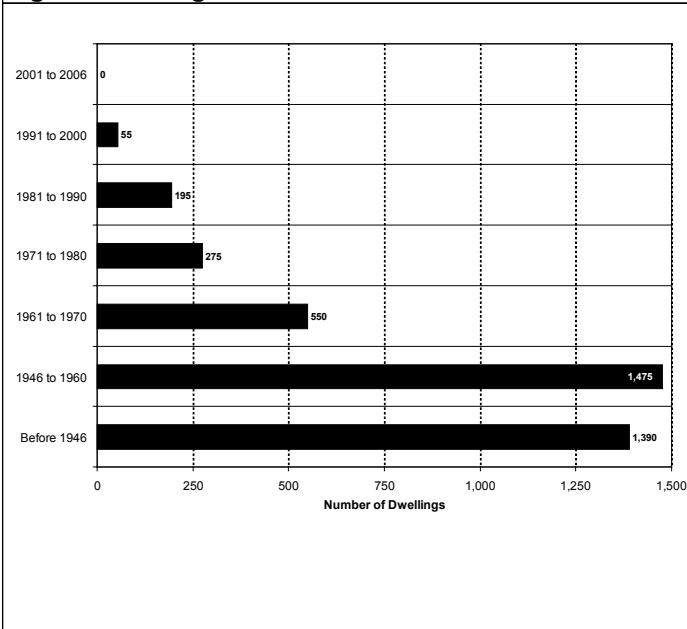
Type of Housing Stock
