

North Central Community Association Renew Project

Goals

1. Increasing property crime reporting and reducing vandalism by educating residents and property owners about property crimes and the reporting process.
2. Gauge community perceptions, opinions, and ideas regarding city programs as well as community programs and issues by conducting a survey.
3. Increasing community image by engaging residents in taking pride in physical environment of neighbourhood through volunteer and social events.
4. Improve support for victims of vandalism by removing or repairing damage by working with offenders and community volunteers.

Process:

The process is starting off with delivering an introduction flyer to residents of targeted blocks notifying of when Renew Project staff will return to conduct a survey and solicit volunteers for the work bee. Renew Project staff will then conduct the survey and educate residents on the reporting process for graffiti as well as other NCCA programs. This is followed by conducting the work bee with the community participation to pick up garbage, covering graffiti and minor yard work. After the work bee, staff will host a community block party to encourage community engagement and communication.

Our target is to have 9 community workbees and each will work with one side of two different streets to target the shared alleys. Approximately 40 households for each work bee will benefit directly from each event.
