

City of Regina Map with North Central Highlighted


Introduction

The neighbourhood profiles provide demographic and household information from the 2016 Census. The data was obtained from Statistics Canada through the community data program and compiled by the City of Regina.







Marital status for the population aged 15 years and over in private households







Household total income groups in 2015 for private households (Pre & Post Tax)






